1. Cyprian Izod. Izod (or sometimes Iszard) was his grandmother Eleanor Whillock's maiden name.
2. Jane, wife of Cyprian was buried four days after her daughter Anne (details taken from Bishops Transcript for Stanway). Need to find out if there was some disease in the area at the time.
3. Only known surviving male was Cyprian Izod bt 24.4.1774. On 8.12.1774, 10 months later, Thomas and Susannah Whillock also baptised a child Cypian in Great Comberton.

### Notes

On the IGI I found an Edmund Peel Whillock baptised 27.8.1819 in Tamworth Staffs. Parents were William and Elizabeth Whillock. Could this be William listed above and could Edmund Peel have been "our" Edmund, perhaps a late baptism? Several other "Peel Whillock's" listed in Free BMD lists but as yet can find no connection. See misc Whillocks.

Were Hester Nash and Elizabeth Nash sisters?

Was Thomas son of George and Eleanor? Dates suggest that he may be. Need to find parents.

1. Can find no marriage for Thomas or Lucy. Lucy's dates taken from census returns & death index (see misc Whillock's)
2. Edward bt 17.4.1803. Listed on IGI as Edwd. Could this be Edmund born 1798? Also baptised on same day was Elizabeth. Were they twins or simply children baptised together? Need to check register.
3. Believe that Edward was in fact Edmund and that the two brothers migrated to *Chertsey, Surrey*. Think that William married Martha Lice on 4 October 1842 in *Chertsey* but need to investigate this further.

### Notes

1. Where is Sarah's baptism entry? We know she was born in Tewkesbury c 1830 and that Edmund was her father. Need to check 1841 & 1851 census for Chertsey as dates suggest that the family went to there between 1829 and 1833.
2. Is Edmund actually the Edward, son of Thomas and Lucy ?
3. Strange moving pattern, First known child was born Tewkesbury, second in Great Comberton, third (poss Sarah) back in Tewkesbury and fourth in Chertsey. Why did the family go to Chertsey and where did they go from there? Possible leads in South London. Need to check. Also other possibility for deaths of children on Burial Index.
4. Have discovered other Whillocks that I knew nothing about that were living in Chertsey. Need to investigate.

On a list of Whillock civil registration deaths is listed Cyprian Whillock, born 1801 and died 1869 (aged 68) in Pershore (Great Comberton comes under the Pershore district). Also listed is Jane Whillock born 1790 and died 1869 (age 79) in Pershore. Are these Jane and Cyprian above? If so Cyprian would have been 29 and Jane 40 when they married and they died in the same month. Need to research further.

## VARIOUS CYPRIAN'S ! (Prepare to be confused!)

1. Cyprian, son of George and Eleanor born 1737 in Stanway, Gos. Married Jane Cheslin in Dumbleton, Gos 18.11.1761
2. Cyprian Izod, son of above, bt 24.4.1774 in Stanway. No further information on him.
3. Cyprian, son of Thomas and Susannah, bt 8.12.1774 in Great Comberton, Worc, just 8 months after Cyprian above. Buried 21/1/1814 age 40 in Great Comberton.
4. Cyprian who married Jane Heath in Worcester 1830. Had two girls in Worcester and Hereford in 1831 and 1835. Who were his parents?
5. There is a record of a Cyprian Whillock, a Whitesmith in Tewkesbury, Gos in an 1830 trade directory. Likely to be Cyprian no 4 as 2 & 3 would have been 56 years old assuming they reached adulthood. Who were his parents? Likely to be Thomas and Lucy, as Thomas was also listed in the directory working as a blacksmith, but have no firm record.
6. Found a death entry for Cyprian Whillock in Pershore (Great Comberton registration district) December 1869. Also death entry for Jane Whillock in same month. Cyprian is listed as being born in 1801 so can't be 1, 2 or 3. May be Cyprian 4 and/or 5.
7. Just to confuse matters there is a Cyprian recorded who died in Tewkesbury in 1850 (no age recorded). This could be Cyprian no 2, Cyprian no 4/5 or was there a fifth Cyprian that we know nothing about? The search continues!!!



## MISCELLANEOUS WHILLOCKS & QUERIES

1. George Whillock, son of George and Eleanor who married Rachel Smearing in Stanway 26.12.1749. Both buried Stanway. Did they have any children and who were they?
2. In 1851 census there was a Charles Whillock living in Barton Street, Tewkesbury. Info given as born Tewkesbury 1813 (age 38) occupation a shoeing smith. Who are his parents? Most likely candidates are Thomas and Lucy as dates and places tie up.
3. Much earlier Whillocks seem to be concentrated in the Biddulph area of Staffordshire. As George (married to Eleanor) appears to be our earliest Whillock, need to try and find his parents.
4. On IGI have found five children of William Whillock and Elizabeth. Is this William, son of Thomas & Susannah and his wife Elizabeth nee Nash who married 1803? Would have expected children sooner and names do not follow the usual Whillock pattern but a possibility as Tamworth is not far from Great Comberton, Stanway, Tewkesbury triangle, although William was buried in Great Comberton.

All baptised in Tamworth, Staffordshire.  
  
A strange occurrence, Edmund Peel Willock is also registered on IGI as being baptised on the same day (27.8.1819) in Hawkshead, Lancashire. Why?
6. Have three "unknown" Whillocks that I believe may belong to Thomas and Lucy. They are Edmund (born 1798 and known to have lived in Tewkesbury), Cyprian (born 1801 - date taken from death record & worked in Tewkesbury) and Charles (born Tewkesbury 1813 and

still living and working there as a shoeing smith in 1851 census).

There are several W(h)illocks (excluding Cyprian's!) taken from the Civil Registration list and National Burial Index that I cannot yet find a connection with although they all died or were buried in Chertsey, Great Comberton or Tewkesbury.

They are:

Thomas Willock, buried 4 November 1788, Great Comberton

Esther Willock, buried 30 April 1829, age 67 (born 1762), St Peter, Little Comberton

Eleanor Whillock, died quarter September 1841, Chertsey, Surrey

Martha Crockford Whillock, died quarter June 1845, Chertsey, Surrey

George Whillock, died quarter December 1850, Chertsey, Surrey

Susannah Whillock, died quarter December 1877 age 69 (born 1808) Chertsey, Surrey.

William Whillock, died quarter December 1840, Pershore\*

Hester Whillock, died quarter December 1844, Pershore

Elizabeth Whillock, died quarter December 1863, Pershore

Jane Whillock, died quarter December 1869, Pershore

\* Pershore is the registration district for Great Comberton.
