Descendants of Joseph Wheelock

Thank you for your letter of 9th July, I have now completed the searches requested, as follows: -

1. Arthur Wheelock

I would imagine that you have probably quoted the wrong name here, since the descendants of Arthur Wheelock are presumably as given by your South African correspondent?

2. Marriage Certificate – Joseph Walford Wheelock

The enclosed certificate confirms that he married Eleanor Mary Scott.

3. Birth Certificate – Doris Mary Elizabeth Wheelock

This certificate is enclosed. In addition, I have searched the GRO birth indexes from the date of this birth up to the end of 1916, but there are no other likely Wheelock births in Lambeth or the surrounding area up to the June quarter of 1911. The birth indexes from September 1911 onwards include the mother's maiden name and there is no Wheelock birth shown anywhere in England or Wales from that point up to the end of 1916 where the mother's maiden name is given as Scott. Hence it would seem very unlikely that there were any other children of this marriage.

4. Marriage Certificate – Jessie Wheelock

The enclosed certificate confirms that she married William Henry Budd.

5. Will – Joseph Wheelock

Copies of the will and probate grant are enclosed.

6. Marriage Certificate – Harry Wheelock

The enclosed marriage certificate shows that his wife was indeed named Edith Grace Tuckwood.

7. Birth Certificate – Norman Harry Wheelock

Another search of the birth indexes for the birth of any Wheelock whose mother's maiden name was Tuckwood eventually found a Norman H Wheelock, born in 1921, and the enclosed certificate gives his full name as Norman Harry Wheelock.

8. Death Certificate – Norman Harry Wheelock

Having established that the Harry Wheelock referred to by your correspondent was actually named Norman Harry; I then searched the GRO death indexes back from the present, finding his death in 1996, as shown on the enclosed certificate.

Since the above death certificate reveals that his widow was named Aurora Lidia Wheelock, it should be possible to find her marriage to Norman Harry and the names of any children, if required.

I trust that the enclosures will prove of interest and look forward to hearing further from you in due course.
